Unruly Behaviour	The most important rule of all is that the operator’s decision is final, refusal to abide by the operators guidance will result in ride refusal& in extreme circumstances closure of the unit.	1	2	2	None
Electrocution	Electrical units are visually inspected for obvious faults. All equipment is PAT tested once a year, cables are covered and only trained and insured staff should have access.	1	3	3	If sockets are used at the venue, we ask the client to check these prior to event.
Injury through spectator being hit by equipment	Operator is to inform spectators where to stand to ensure they are at a safe distance from the machine.	1	2	2	Equipment set up away from spectators.

L=Likelihood S=Severity L X S = Risk Score with 1 = Lowest Risk and 25 = Highest

Risk and likelihood are worked out using numbers 1-5. These are then multiplied to give the risk score. We recommend that clients undertake their own risk assessment to suit individual needs.

We strive to have no risk score over 10 and anything over 20 would result in ES Promotions not running the kit.

METHOD STATEMENT FOR SALOON BAR SHOOTOUT

All measurements in 'ft'.

UNIT SIZE (W x H x D)	3 x 7 x 1
MIN. AREA REQ. (W x D)	8 x 10

1)

Arrival on site

- > Find a safe and practical entrance point to unload kit
- > Confirm location is suitable for equipment
- > Confirm where power is available from
- > Ensure ground is flat and free from obstructions
- > Allow a minimum of 2ft (0.6m) clearance around unit

2)

The Set Up

- > Use sackbarrow to place unit into position
- > Undo butterfly clasps, and open out either side fully
- > Unscrew the 4 black headed bolts holding the metal frame holsters
- > Remove both holsters, and place approx 3ft from the unit, in front
- > Screw the 4 black headed bolts back into the holes
- > Place the guns in each holster, and connect the phono leads located on the side of the metal frame
- > Plug in the kettle lead, and plug into an extension if necessary, or a nearby wall socket if it reaches
- > Plug in the power operated remote, that controls when the game starts and finishes; you can use the wireless remote, but this ensures you have a back up, should the wireless fail to work
- > If head room allows, unscrew the board that is attached to the right hand side door, and place on top of the unit, in the grooved wooden plinth

- > Test the game by pressing the wired / wireless remote, and fire both guns; you MUST cock the gun each time before shooting, otherwise the trigger will not work

3) **The Operation**

- > This unit is designed for 2 people at a time
- > Stand by the unit for the duration of the event; if you must leave, take the remote with you
- > You will need to briefly explain to each person that plays, that they must start with their hands a few inches away from the gun, then when the doors open and the timer begins, they must pull the gun out, cock it, and fire aiming towards the unit; winner is the player with the lowest time

4) **The Pack Down**

- > Ensure the area is clear of guests before commencing the pack down
- > Simply reverse the steps shown in The Set Up
- > Load van in a safe and secure manner, before checking area for equipment
